School Uniform Purchasing

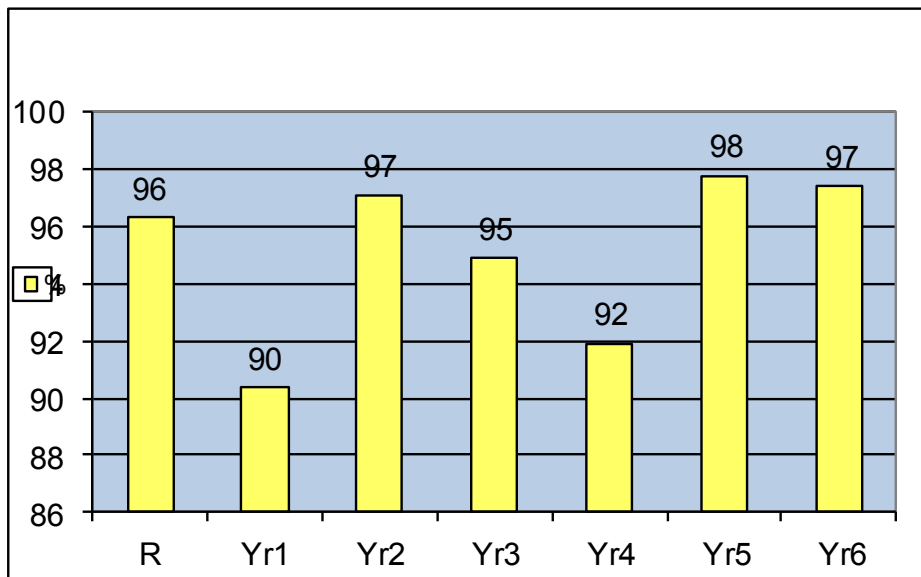
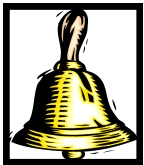
Please note that the school office will be open on Friday 1st September from 9-11am and all day Monday 4th Sept for those wishing to purchase uniform.
